**Music Icon Stevie Wonder To Headline  
World Shoe Association's Benefit Concert**

**22-Time Grammy Winner Continues WSA &  
Two Ten Footwear Foundation's Superstar Tradition August 4**

Newport Beach, CA — April 15, 2005 —The World Shoe Association (WSA), producers of the premier footwear industry trade shows in The Americas, and the Two Ten Foundation, the non-profit organization focused on the footwear industry, today announced the August 2005 "Shoe Party" benefit concert will feature legendary performer, R&B and popular music icon, Stevie Wonder.

The Opening Night concert highlights the opening night of the ultimate, must-attend WSA Show for the footwear industry on the first day of the WSA Show, Thursday, August 4, 2005, at the 7,000-seat Aladdin Performing Arts Center in Las Vegas. Attendees will enjoy a night of entertainment with Stevie Wonder at WSA's Opening Night "Shoe Party," the industry's premier social forum. Stevie Wonder, the American Icon and Rock & Roll Hall of Fame inductee, whose career has spanned over four decades, selling 72 million albums with 37 #1 singles, including 19 Grammy Awards, one Oscar, a Golden Globe and numerous American Music Awards and Soul Train Music Awards, will deliver an absolutely legendary performance. "Since Stevie Wonder no longer tours, but only does private performances such as this one, we are providing a rare treat for the footwear industry," stated Stone.

The August WSA Show takes place in Las Vegas August 4-7, 2005, drawing more than 30,000 participants. The show features 1,600 exhibitors showcasing more than 6,000 brands

at the Mandalay Bay Convention Center, the Sands Expo Center and nearly 350 suites at The Venetian.
